



Slanted Shells Edges

Finish afghan with sc all around as shown in Baby Afghan in BS 101, Fig. 3

Use same color a sc row.

1. Insert hook at corner under 2 strands of sc and pull a loop through, ch 3 to start, do 2 dc in same sc, 1 sc in next sc, to keep corner flat. * Ch 3, 2 dc in last sc, skip 2 sc, 1 sc in third sc, rep from * to next corner. Just before corner skip more or less sc sts to fit corner pattern as needed.

Work all around and sl st to starting sc. Cut yarn, hide end. Fig. 1

FINAL EDGING, Fig. 2.

Insert hook in ch-3 sp at corner and pull a loop through, * ch 3, sl st in next ch-3 sp, rep from * all around, sl st to starting point. Cut yarn.

RUFFLED EDGING, Fig. 3.

Insert hook in sc at corner, * ch 4, sc in ch-3 sp, ch 3 in sc between shells, rep from * all around and sl to starting point. Cut yarn.

DOUBLE ROW OF SHELLS, Fig. 4.

Turn work around after the first row of slanted shells is finished. Use another color. Pull a loop through ch-3 sp before corner, ch 3, 2 dc in same ch-3 sp, to inc at corner do 1 sc in sc right at corner, ch 3, 2 dc in same sc at corner, * sc in next ch-3 sp, 2 dc in same ch-3 sp, rep from *

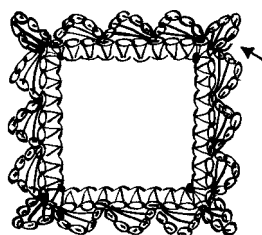

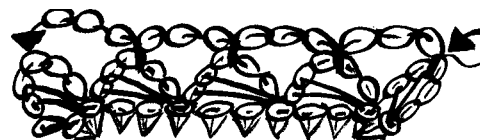

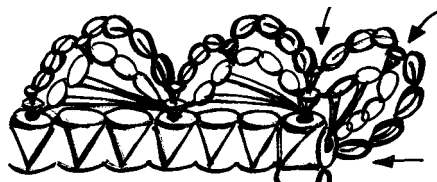
